### Lieutenant Governor of Georgia, Casey Cagle, to Serve as Honorary Ball Chair

We are excited to announce that Lieutenant Governor of Georgia, Casey Cagle, will serve as Honorary Ball Chair for The Circle for Children 2018 fundraising ball "Vintage to Vogue."

A successful entrepreneur and respected former State Senator, Cagle made history in 2006 by becoming the first Republican elected to Georgia's second highest office, Lieutenant Governor. Georgia voters overwhelming re-elected Cagle as Lieutenant Governor in 2010 and 2014.

Cagle's family has called Georgia home for seven generations. His leadership has been recognized beyond the state of Georgia as well. After being named one of the "100 Most Influential Georgians," Cagle was one of only four public servants in the country to be honored by the National Alliance for Public Charter Schools with the Champion for Charters Award.

## A Message from President-Elect, Lynn Thompson






