## Finance Committee News-A Guide to Paying Online at the Circle Website

Sometimes technology can get the best of even the most tech savvy amongst us!

I've been getting some email and calls from members who are having a heck of a time purchasing items on our website. And that's a problem!

To help, I've decided to write an easy "How to Make a Purchase on the Circle Website for Dummies!' No, you are not a dummy, and you are not alone. So, if you are one of the members having problems, please print out this step-by-stop guide and keep it by your computer.

- 1. Go to the <u>www.circle4children.org</u> website and click on the **Events and Payments** tab.
- 2. Now click on **Payment**. You will then be directed to our main shopping page.
- 3. Choose the item you want to purchase and hit the yellow Add to Cart button

4. If the item you want to purchase has a drop-down menu like below, simply hit the down arrow and choose the number or level that you want. Then hit **Add to Cart**


- 5. Once you hit **Add to Cart** you will be automatically directed to the payments page. If you are not done shopping, simply click on the **Continue Shopping** button at the top right hand of the page. You will then be directed back to the shopping page. Just repeat **Add to Cart** and **Continue Shopping** until you have completed your shopping.
- 6. Once you are done shopping and you are on the payment page, check to make sure your shopping cart is correct. If you see a mistake, simply hit **Remove** under the item and it will be removed from your cart. You can also change the **Quantity** at this time also.
- 7. Now you are ready to pay. If you have a PayPal account you can choose the **PayPal Checkout** button in yellow. \*\*If you do not have a PayPal account chose the grey **Check Out** button instead.
- 8. Now fill in the boxes with your name and credit card information and click on the **Pay Now** blue button. Viola, you are done. A receipt will come to your email.

Isn't that easy? If you are paying dues, the only difference is that first you go to the Membership tab on our website and follow along the prompts to pay dues. By the way, have you paid your dues yet?
