### SCHOLARSHIP UPDATE

### Urgent Need for Gap Scholarship Funds for Circle Scholar

Due to a decrease in state funding for college age foster kids, two of our Circle Scholars, Joshua Elisa & Y'Lon Alston need additional funds to stay in school.

Joshua needs at least \$7,500. He is a senior at Reinhardt University studying Business Management. Y'Lon needs \$2000 for his freshman year as a Math major at KSU. There are 10 other CCYA

students impacted by the budget cuts. Instead of providing up to \$12,500 in tuition dollars, Georgia is only providing up to \$5,000. Eligible students were notified after classes started that they were short on funds

CCYA set up a fund for donations to fill the gap and keep the CCYA young adults in school. If they receive more from Circle members then the amount needed to keep Josh and Y'Lon in school, those additional funds will go to other CCYA students. Kim Borna will report back to the circle with details on where our member donations go.
